At the beginning of each week, starting April 6th, each core subject will suggest a few learning activities. These challenges are not mandatory, nor will they be graded in anyway. We will also be including our e-mails so that feedback can be given to us and so that we can help in any way necessary. Note that all challenges are based on concepts already learned and that we are not asking for at-home teaching of new concepts.

O.E.S. has obtained an IXL website trial that will be used during the month of April. The use of this website is optional and not graded.

IXL is a site that covers Quebec's mathematics curriculum and provides practice on math concepts and skills. All questions answered provide students, parents and teachers with statistics concerning students' strengths, weaknesses and time spent practicing. Students are also continuously being given awards (online certificates) by the site for their efforts. I do recommend having paper and a pencil near for some calculations.
