

Hercules Character Mash-Up Video

A Music & Performing Arts Project

Dear Grade 5/6 families,

I invite all students to create a one-minute video where they will present themselves as their character that they would have portrayed in our production of Hercules.

The video should be filmed as such:

- Each student **should be in character** throughout the **one-minute** video (very important). You may add some costuming if you wish.
- Each student should describe who their character is.
- Each student should explain their motives in the play (what do they want, what might they be overcoming).
- Each student should explain how their character feels about Hercules. For the two Hercules characters, they should describe how Hades makes them feel.
- Each student should recite their favourite part or their favourite line from the play.

Remember that in your video you are always in character and not responding as yourself.

Please respect the maximum length of one minute, it will help keep the video from being over an hour long. If you end up with less than a minute, example 30-45 seconds, that is fine. **Just make sure you bring your best performance and remember: acting is reacting! So don't forget to show emotion.**

Send all one-minute videos to tirwin@nfsb.qc.ca by May 31st so that we can get the video edited and ready before the end of the year.
